

**BREEDING CONTRACT FOR BONHEUR
Fresh and Cooled Semen**

Subject to the following terms and conditions, I, the undersigned (hereinafter Mare Owner), hereby agrees to breed the mare _____ to the Elite Hanoverian Stallion, **BONHEUR**, during the 2008 breeding season.

The stud fee of \$1,800.00 for fresh or cooled semen includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$400.00 that is payable with this contract. If transported semen is used; the entire stud fee is due and payable before semen will be shipped. All shipped semen deposits are also due before semen will be shipped. Said shipping fees are listed in the attached Addendum.

If the mare needs to be re-bred the following season for any reason, a new, non-refundable booking fee of \$400.00 must be paid and received by stallion owner before shipment each season transported semen is requested.

Mare owner understands that this signed contract and booking fee must be returned to stallion owner to initiate this contract. Mare Owner also understands that to retain re-breeding rights under the live foal guarantee, the mare owner must also supply a Veterinarian Certificate of Insemination and Pregnancy Examination by September 1, 2008 for all breeding preformed by shipped semen.

Stallion Owner agrees that if the stud fee is paid and said mare subsequently, as a result of this breeding, does not have a live foal that can stand and nurse unassisted, the stud fee will be carried forward to the next breeding season. If a live foal has not resulted from this mating after two seasons, the live foal guarantee is null and void. At that time, however, Garner Creek Farms will allow Mare Owner to breed mare to any other Stallion owned by Garner Creek Farms for a 25% discount off of that Stallion's total stud fee. If the mare stated on this contract is found unsound for breeding after a full veterinary exam, the mare owner may substitute another mare with the written consent of Garner Creek Farms. Thereafter, this contract will be deemed fulfilled. Should the stud fee charged by the Stallion Owner change, the mare owner will not be expected to pay the difference, but will have to repay the booking fee and shipping deposits each breeding season. Once a live foal has been delivered, assisted or unassisted, that can stand and nurse unassisted, this contract is deemed fulfilled. In the case of the birth of twins, alive or stillborn, this contract is deemed fulfilled.

The stud fee will be carried forward with the valid live foal guarantee only if the Mare Owner has properly maintained the health of the mare and verifies the mare's pregnancy loss, stillbirth, or newborn foal death by notifying Sharon Garner by facsimile and/or e-mail within 48 hours of the loss and sending a signed and dated veterinary certificate clearly stating the following:

1. ID of the mare named herein.
2. Verification of the loss of pregnancy or stillbirth
3. Verification that, in the vet's best judgment, the mare was maintained in a reasonable state of health, including vaccinations and de-worming and that monitoring of the mare around the time of parturition was adequate enough to reasonably detect and attend to any foaling difficulties.

The above veterinary certificate must be received by Stallion Owner within ten (10) days of the discovery of mare's pregnancy loss, stillbirth, or newborn foal death, and in any case, prior to further breeding of said mare or semen shipments to said mare.

The breeding season for **BONHEUR** is defined as March 1, 2008 until July 15, 2008. It is further understood and agreed that if either the sire or the mare dies or becomes unfit for service **PRIOR** to breeding the mare, by whatever means, then the stud fee and any deposits paid will be refunded and this contract shall become null and void. Should the sire die or become unfit for service during the life of this contract and frozen semen is available to fulfill the Station Owner's obligations under this contract, then the mare owner will be shipped frozen semen, subject to the deposits and fees required for the handling and shipping of said frozen semen.

Mare Owner understands that 48 Hours **Advanced Notice** must be given to Stallion owner for collection of semen. If less than 48 hours advance notice is given, the request will be accommodated if possible.

Mare Owner is responsible for having his own veterinarian culture the mare prior to breeding if transported semen is to be utilized. The sire owner prior to insemination requires a copy of the negative culture. A licensed veterinarian must perform all inseminations.

Mare Owner must have a licensed veterinarian examine the mare to determine the phase of ovulation and recommend the proper time to request shipment of semen. Stallion owner may request written verification of the examination.

Mare Owner understands that **BONHEUR** may be away at a competition on the date that semen is requested and that frozen semen, if available, will be shipped instead. The extra deposits required for frozen semen would be the responsibility of the mare owner and arrangements for the shipment of frozen semen must be made in advance with Select Breeders Services, Inc. If mare owner prefers not to use frozen semen, then mare owner may have to wait until a subsequent cycle to breed said mare or may opt to breed mare to another available stallion of Garner Creek Farms if Stallion owner and mare owner can agree to reasonable terms. Stallion Owner will do everything reasonable, however, to accommodate mare at each cycle.

I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that I am the mare owner named herein or a duly authorized agent thereof and as such have the authority to enter into this contract. I also certify that I have read and understand this contract and attached fee schedules.
